JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Purpose: to recognize Junior Connemara riders and encourage them to pursue continuing educational activities with their Connemaras

Winners shall be awarded \$200.

Second place shall be awarded \$100.

All remaining applications which are worthy of Honorable Mention shall receive \$25 each.

Policies:

Applicants shall be current individual or family members of the ACPS.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or under as of January 1st of the application year.

The Connemara, purebred or halfbred, must be registered with the ACPS but does not have to be owned by the rider.

The application must include the full registered name and registration number of the horse.

If awarded, funds must be used to further the equestrian education of the horse and/or rider.

Applications may continue to be made in future years.
