Thanks for nominating your Connemara Pony(ies) for inspection. Below you will see the information you will need to bring to the inspection and the schedule for the inspection site. Please be aware that this schedule is a guideline and be prepared to make allowances regarding times. In most instances, 45 minutes are allotted for stallions, and 30 minutes are allowed for mares and geldings. Be prepared to be at least one pony ahead in the schedule just in case.

You will need to bring the following with you to the inspection:

- The attached ACPS veterinarian form, including the height of the pony, which must be filled out and signed by your veterinarian. This can be completed when your vet fills out any state required travel health certificates (usually these have to be completed no more than a month from the travel dates).
- Your original Coggins result form (valid for one year) as required by site/ state.
- Two (2) Photos of your pony(ies), 1 head on and the other a side view. These will be collected to be put in the pony's inspection file which is archived with the ACPS.
- Your original registration certificate which will have a seal affixed if the pony is approved for original and/or premium inspection.
