INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Copy this form as necessary.
2. Complete one form for each pony nominated.
3. Attach a copy of the nominated pony's ACPS registration certificate
4. Indicate site preferred.
5. Submit all paperwork and fees by site deadline. No pony is officially nominated until the completed nomination form, fees and required documents are received by Marynell Eyles.
6. NOTE: The Veterinarian Inspection Report Form will be sent in the nomination packet by the Inspections Chair OR may downloaded from the Inspections page of the ACPS website(acps.org). This form must be completed and signed by your veterinarian, including the height measurement section at the top of the form and brought to inspection.

What ponies are eligible for inspection?

- All purebred Connemara ponies, domestic or imported, with an ACPS permanent registration certificate are eligible for inspection.
- Connemara ponies presented for inspection should be representative of Connemara pony breed type and conformation, according to the breed standard.
- The minimum age for ponies to be inspected is 2 yrs. 3 yrs is the preferred minimum age for stallion prospects.
