### Mission Statement

#### Definition (ACPS By Laws, Article IX, Committees)

The Inspection Committee shall be responsible for all aspects of the inspection process including certification of inspectors, assign inspection number, operations, and education. The chairperson shall be appointed by the President of the Society. Committee members and chairpersons of any subcommittees shall be appointed by the Chairperson.

#### Mission Statement

##### I. ACPS Inspection Committee Mission Statement:

The American Connemara Pony Society is committed to the impartial Inspection of purebred ponies in order to preserve and protect the purity and integrity of the Connemara Pony breed in North America. The Inspection Committee is dedicated to the maintenance and preservation of the Connemara Pony as defined by the breed standard.

##### II. The Purpose of the Inspection Process shall include :

To be instructive and educational to breeders and the general public with respect to Connemara breed type, conformation, movement and attributes; to encourage and maintain a working definition of breed type and Breed Standard; to preserve the unique qualities of the Connemara through encouraging selective breeding for Connemara type with correct conformation, athletic movement and a willing, tractable temperament as described in the ACPS Breed Standard; to identify and give recognition to approved breeding stock; to continue to maintain and preserve the highest standard of Connemara Pony Breeding.
